Adopted resolution

on the Green Adriatic Network

Marine environment is extremely sensitive to technogenic influence. European seas are under growing industrial pressure. Green networking in Mediterranean, North Sea and Baltic is an important tool to prevent further environmental degradation and non-sustainability in marine regions.

Adriatic Sea is still relatively clean, but seriously endangered by international industrial initiatives, intensive tourism and coastal infrastructure problems. It is also an area of multicultural coexistence marked with political complexities. Greens can and should play the role of a harmonising factor there.

EFGP asbl welcomes the creation of the Green Adriatic Network initiated by East-West Green Dialogue participants and considers its further development within the EFGP asbl framework as an important direction of European Greens activities.
